- > Attending a TV or radio show related to the literary scene (if the opportunity arises)

- > Be available from May 28 to June 3, 2023 in Paris
- > Be an editorial executive/manager in Literature or the Humanities (no children's books, YA, or illustrated books)
- > Manage French sufficiently to be able to read a text in French and to understand someone speaking in French
- > Be able to express yourself in French or in English

- > Participants' hotel bills will be paid by the BIEF, which also pays a per diem (50€/day)
- > Participants will pay their own traveling expenses
