Are you French-speaking parents? Would you like your children to continue practising French while enrolled in a British school? Then wait no more and join the FLAM network!

What is FLAM?

The Français LAngue Maternelle network brings together associations located outside of France whose mission is to reinforce the language skills and cultural knowledge of children from French and French-speaking families, aged between 3 and 18 and who do not attend school in French, through extra-curricular activities.

The FLAM associations, created by groups of locally based French-speaking parents, are supported by the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs through the AEFE (the Agency for French Education Abroad).

What do the FLAM associations offer?

The FLAM associations, also known as *Petites Écoles* in the UK, offer French-speaking families courses and holiday camps in French, enabling their children to develop, maintain or recover their fluency in French, in a setting that is both educational and fun, on evenings or weekends.





In the UK, the FLAM network is supported by Parapluie FLAM, a non-profit association that federates more than 60 *Petites Écoles* across the country.

The Parapluie FLAM provides educational, administrative and legal support to help set up associations, allowing the pooling of resources and the sharing of best practices between network members.


