

PRIZE DRAW TERMS & CONDITIONS

Introduction

By entering the prize draw you agree to these prize draw's terms and conditions. The prize draw is being run by the Institut français du Royaume-Uni (IFRU).

Eligibility to Enter

The competition is open to entrants over 18 years of age and residents in the UK. IFRU's employees and associates are excluded from the draw.

By entering the prize draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and that you are eligible to receive any prizes that may be awarded to you.

There is a limit of one entry per person and the prize draw is completely free to enter.

How to Enter

To enter the prize draw, one must complete a form stating their name, email address, and their favourite French novel published in 2023, online or onsite using one of the ballots on display at the box-office of the Cultural Centre (17 Queensberry Place, London SW72DT) or at the reception of the Language Centre (13 Queensberry Place, London SW7 2JN).

The form will be available from the 14th of November 2023 to the 3rd of December 2023, midnight. Entries after these dates will not be considered in the prize draw.

IFRU will not accept responsibility if the contact details provided are incomplete or inaccurate.

The Prize

The winning prize will be a one-year Premium Membership to the Institut français du Royaume-Uni. The membership card will be redeemable within 3 months after the prize announcement.
